Minutes:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's ***Antitrust Guidelines*** – which all attendees were familiar with.
3. The status of the IADC Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program was discussed. The lack of respondents filling out the form completely was reviewed. Efforts to solicit additional participation were discussed. Using an example of the survey to demonstrate its brevity and help solicit participants was discussed. A desire by some Drilling Contractors to do a “data dump” of historical top drive downtime events for their individual data systems was discussed.

Action Item: Mike Killalea to invite the members of the IADC Maintenance Committee to provide examples of raw data they can furnish on information on top drive downtime events they may have in other databases.

Action Item: Mike Killalea to post an example of the downtime form in an Adobe Acrobat (pdf) format and post same on the IADC website.

4. The status of the IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** was discussed. Mike Killalea discussed the need to convert the documents to an HTML format.

Action Item: All to review the current draft and provide changes before the next meeting of the group.
