## **Minutes:**

1. Subcommittee Chairman opened the meeting and welcomed the participants.
2. The IADC Antitrust Policy was reviewed and noted as being available on the IADC website.
3. Immediately preceding the holidays, the meeting was lightly attended and opened with general discussions regarding our current focus on "*Integration with the Downhole Systems*" and collaboration with SPE Drilling System Technical Section (DSATS). Work must continue to define the various "drilling scenarios" and attendees agreed to research their respective company's documents to see if they provided the level of detail and share these if appropriate. Future workshops and conferences must also be used as potential research and information gathering pools.
4. We have yet to document this effort under IADC's structure of Mission Statement, Goals and Objectives, and the subcommittee chairman committed to draft these for review at the next meeting.

The chairman noted that during an independent meeting with Energistics, they had expressed their appreciation of Clinton Chapman's presentation on the SPE work underway on WITS/OPC interface and stated that they were interested in a 'higher level' of participation in the initiative. A follow-up meeting will be scheduled, including Clinton and Fred Florence.
