Minutes:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group. Introductions were made.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's ***Antitrust Guidelines*** – which all attendees were familiar with.
3. The status of the IADC's ***Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program*** was discussed. The lack of respondents filling out the form completely was reviewed. Efforts to solicit additional participation were discussed. It was noted that Mike Killalea had sent an email to members of the IADC Maintenance committee and had received a response.
4. The status of the IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** was discussed and reviewed on-line. Efforts to add photos and training sources were discussed. The ability to print was the on-line IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** was discussed.

Ongoing Action Item: All to review the on-line IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** and provide additional photos and training sources.

Action Item: Mike Killalea to remove the three (3) photos from the IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** that lack sources. These are currently photos # 8, # 12 and # 13.

5. Development of a ***Pipe Handling Reliability Statistics Program*** questionnaire was discussed. This would be limited PLC based pipe handling equipment. The group felt a down-time statistics program might be a better project – rather than separate statistics programs for each type of equipment on a Rig. Development of standard definitions was discussed to develop comparable statistics. The need to maintain Drilling Contractor confidentiality was discussed. Developing this system jointly with interested members of the IADC Maintenance committee was discussed.

The IADC Safety statistics program was discussed as an example that is time tested and works. It was mentioned Joe Hurt is the IADC staff in charge of this program.
