## **Minutes:**

1. Robert Urbanowski (Chairing the meeting for Logan Puckett) welcomed the group. There were introductions by the meeting attendees.
2. The IADC's Antitrust Guidelines were discussed and copies distributed to those who were unfamiliar with them.
3. The top drive reliability survey was discussed. Difficulties were encountered when trying to develop a system where (a) multiple people could submit information on same downtime event, (b) requirement for a username and password and (c) ability to change record after initially input. Whether a simpler survey type system would work was discussed. It was decided an individual could contact the IADC if information already submitted needed to be changed. Andy Shelton would meet with the IADC the next day to discuss ways to set up a survey that will allow collection of this data. Goal is to have this survey system working before the IADC 2009 ART conference.
4. The matrix this subgroup had worked on would be called the "*IADC Technology Value Guide*". This matrix will be expanded in the future to (a) click on the name of each topic and get pictures and definitions, (b) get a list of manufacturers for that equipment and (c) get a list of training sources for that equipment. It was decided that definitions would be developed with the help of Petroleum Extension Service of the University of Texas at Austin (PETEX). The goal to complete these photos and definitions is within the next sixty (60) days.
5. The IADC's 2009 ART conference was discussed.
6. It was decided the next meeting would be 14-Oct-2009 at 8:30 AM CST at the IADC office in Houston, Texas.
