## Minutes:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's **Antitrust Guidelines** – which all attendees were familiar with.
3. The status of the IADC's **Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program** was discussed. The lack of respondents filling out the form completely was reviewed. Efforts to solicit additional participation were discussed. It was noted that Mike Killalea had posted a sample questionnaire on the IADC's **Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program** website. Randy Pyrch indicated he has been contacting some of the smaller Drilling Contractors. Robert Urbanowski indicated NOV has committed to have their top drive rental fleet group participate – but still have not formally signed up.

**Action Item:** Mike Killalea to invite the members of the IADC Maintenance Committee to provide examples of raw data they can furnish on information on top drive downtime events they may have in other databases. This should also be accompanied with clarifying the statistics program has been renamed to indicate it will be an on-going effort.

**Action Item:** Mike Killalea to contact participants who have submitted no data and let them know this is occurring.

**Action Item:** Mike Killalea to contact participants who are submitted incomplete data and let them know this is occurring. This should be accompanied by sending their input data back to them as an example.

4. The status of the IADC **Technology Value Guide** was discussed.

**Ongoing Action Item:** All to review the on-line IADC **Technology Value Guide** and provide additional photos and training sources.

5. Methods to attract wider participation in the subcommittee were discussed. This included indentifying company specific gaps and whether the currently monthly meeting schedule was too frequent.

6. Under "Other Business", it was decided the group would start working on the ***Pipe Handling Reliability Statistics Program*** questionnaire would be developed. This would first include identifying manufacturers of PLC based pipe handling equipment who could fill out their models information and develop the questionnaire while using the IADC's ***Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program*** as an example.

**Action Item:** All to identify companies who manufacture PLC controlled pipe handling equipment and submit these companies with contacts to Robert Urbanowski.

**Action Item:** Robert Urbanowski to consolidate this list of pipe handling manufacturers and submit same to Mike Killalea – so Mike can invite these groups to the subcommittee's next meeting in July-2010.

7. It was decided the next meeting would be 14-July-2010 at 08:30 CST at the IADC office.
8. The meeting was adjourned.
