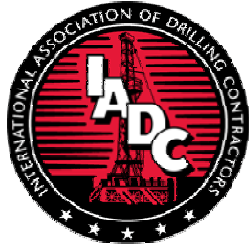

MINUTES:

Reliability SC Vice Chairman Robert Urbanowski opened the meeting and welcomed the participants.

There was a review of the IADC Antitrust Policy and Guidelines with particular emphasis on prohibited discussion topics.

Brian Parks showed the group the revised on-line questionnaire on top-drive downtime. Both definitions page and pop-ups for definitions had been added to this form. A “date for the failure” had also been added. Brian noted Athens Group still needed to add secure access/login features to access the form. It was noted that MH Pyramid’s top drive models still needed to be added. The attendees approved releasing this form for use and population of data once the security issues had been resolved.

Additional goals of MUX Systems and Pipe Handling systems were discussed. Pipehandling was clarified as equipment must be run by a PLC. The need to review the top drive reliability form as the basis for MUX System reliability and Pipe Handling systems reliability was discussed. These items might also require additional definitions.

Under new business, merging both the guidelines workgroup and the reliability workgroup in future meetings was discussed. The group was not opposed to this. The online draft of the guidelines workgroup’s matrix was briefly overviewed, which exist online at:
