Minutes:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group. Introductions for each participant were made.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's **Antitrust Guidelines**.
3. The status of the IADC's **Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program** was discussed. The lack of events being input into the system was discussed. Soliciting a data dump from Drilling Contractor's internal data systems was also discussed.

Action Item: Robert Urbanowski to contact Mike Killalea (IADC) to get (a) a list of number of entries by month, month, and number of participants and (b) the current data in the system.

4. The current on-line IADC **Technology Value Guide** was reviewed. The need for additional photos and training sources was discussed.

Action Item: All to submit photos with proper approvals to be published on the IADC website to Robert Urbanowski or Mike Killalea (IADC).

5. Development of an IADC **Downtime Statistics Program was discussed**. The draft information was reviewed.

Robert Urbanowski reported on meeting with Joe Hurt (IADC) to see if the group can get some lessons learned from when the IADC Safety statistics program was first implemented. Since the system started before Joe started work with the IADC, Joe did not have any concrete lessons learned that would apply.

Action Item: All to submit and existing definitions and key metrics which might be included in this system.
