1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Everyone at the meeting indicated they were familiar with the IADC's **Antitrust Guidelines**, so they were not reviewed in detail during the meeting.
3. Development of an IADC **Downtime Statistics Program** was discussed. R. Urbanowski reported the draft has been sent into the IADC Advanced Rig Technology (ART) Committee. Request to the full committee is to assist in getting Drilling Contractors participating in refining draft.
