Minutes:

Mike Killalea reviewed the agenda as posted on the web site. One minor correction to delete Stefan Miska was noted.

At the last meeting, there was an action to have speakers submit outlines for review at this meeting. None were received. Keith Womer committed to contacting Mark Dykstra and John MacPherson to facilitate coordination of these presentations to avoid overlap. Keith also committed to sending out guidance to the other presenters regarding presentation content and time available. All speakers will be asked to post their presentations if their company policy permits it. Scott Boone had several questions regarding content of the round table presentations which were helpful in clarifying expectations.

We will ask the participants to send copies of their presentations to the list posted on this meeting's agenda. Tom Geehan asked to be added to that list.

At this time, 22 people (outside of workshop participants) are signed up. This is a little behind where we would like to be, but Mike Killalea said there is not cause for alarm. Registration often lags until the last minute. IADC will put out another e-blast. Keith will ask the AADE if they would be willing to post something about the workshop.

Mike Killalea reported that an hour reception after the workshop, consisting of 2 drink tickets and 3 rounds of snacks, would roughly cost \$3000. Scott Boone confirmed that Canrig will assist with funding the reception. He also volunteered that Nabors could co-host with Canrig. Andy Shelton was following up with Sven Ole at NOV to confirm their sponsorship. Hugo Valdez volunteered to check with Pride. Mike confirmed that this is the critical mass we need to say that the reception is definitely on.

Keith Womer confirmed that he submitted an abstract to the IADC/SPE Drilling conference next March reporting on the results of the workshop. Mike Killalea said he would check to see if we are scheduled to present at the August 18 Advanced Rig technology workshop. The next meeting was set for July 20 at 8:30am. At that time, we will review the workshop and prepare for the presentation at the August 18 ART workshop.
