## **Minutes:**

1. David Reid welcomed everyone, and Mike Killalea, covered introductions and referred all to the Antitrust requirements.
2. Robert Urbanowski updated the team on developments within the Reliability and Guidelines Sub-Committee with some assist from the team covering for Logan Puckett who was out of the country. The Top Drive reporting mechanism remains stalled waiting clearance for a solution that can marry the technology with a secure IADC network stored survey solution. Suggestions were proposed to find a means to get this off center and move the project to go live for the sub-committee to consider. The Guidelines matrix is completed and posted in it's first phase and a second phase is in process to work with PETEX on definitions and post the training links for the technologies listed.
3. John Hoeflich, stood in for Terry Loftis and updated the group on the Drilling Control Systems Group. Their efforts have been focused on recruitment to bolster the quality and value of their sub-committee.
4. Future Technologies was presented by David Reid in Frank Springett's absence showing the current status of the latest matrix developed to identify the status of technological advancement of automated applications of equipment and systems to address the issues that have come from the original future technology survey.
5. David Reid provided direction for the meetings the following month to be focused on the output and release of products (Matrices) as well as supporting the development of questions for the ART Conference on the 29th.
