1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's ***Antitrust Guidelines***.
3. The status of the IADC's ***Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program*** was discussed. The lack of participants was discussed. Soliciting a data dump from Drilling Contractor's internal data systems was discussed.
4. The IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** was reviewed. The need for additional photos and training sources was discussed. The recent solicitation for this information sent out from the IADC was mentioned.
