Agenda:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's ***Antitrust Guidelines***. Hard Copies were passed out.
3. The status of the IADC's ***Top Drive Reliability Statistics Program*** was discussed. The lack of respondents filling out the form completely was reviewed. Efforts to solicit additional participation were discussed. Mike Killalea reported we had just a few more incidents turned in over the past month.
4. The status of the IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** was discussed. Mike Killalea reported he had eliminated the three (3) photos without a source indicated. Efforts to add photos and training sources were discussed. Mike Killalea reported that PETEX was interested in publishing the definitions.

Ongoing Action Item: All to review the on-line IADC ***Technology Value Guide*** and provide additional photos and training sources.

5. Development of an IADC ***Downtime Statistics Program*** was discussed. Robert Urbanowski reported he had emailed chair of the ***IADC Maintenance Committee***, but received no response back. Pilot testing a system on a few Rigs with personnel who we know would support gathering data was discussed. Review of existing systems on how data is tracked was also discussed. This would include any critical metrics which are used.

The IADC Safety statistics program was discussed as an example that is time tested and works.

Action Item: Mike Killalea to follow up with the chair of the ***IADC Maintenance Committee*** to determine if there is interest in joint development of this system.
