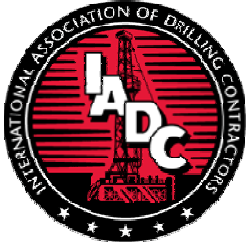

Minutes:

1. Robert Urbanowski welcomed the group.
2. Robert Urbanowski reviewed the IADC's **Antitrust Guidelines** – which all attendees were familiar with.
3. The status of the IADC Top Drive Reliability survey was discussed. The survey is up and running. Robert Urbanowski noted the companies currently participating are Hercules Offshore Co. and KCA DEUTAG. It was mentioned the latest IADC Drill Bits newsletter also mentioned the survey is up and running.
4. There was a brief discussion of the upcoming presentation on the Top Drive Reliability survey at the IADC Maintenance Committee meeting on 13-Jan-2009. Robert Urbanowski had put together a brief PowerPoint presentation for that meeting. Both David Reid and Robert Urbanowski plan to attend that meeting.
5. The status of the IADC **Technology Value Guide** was discussed. Efforts are on-going to add definitions, photos and training sources. Robert Urbanowski noted he solicited photos and training sources from fourteen companies. GE Oil & Gas (Hydril) and Canrig Drilling Technology Ltd. had sent in content to date. It was agreed the IADC would add a cover page to the link to the IADC **Technology Value Guide** requesting additional photos and training sources.
6. Rolling in the subcommittee meetings into one longer IADC ART Committee meeting was discussed. This would have the goal of limiting the number of separate meetings and increased meeting participation. Also discussed was further consolidation of subcommittees and less frequent meetings. It was decided this group was in favor of the single working meeting of the IADC ART Committee.

8. It was decided no additional meetings would be scheduled for this subcommittee at this time.
