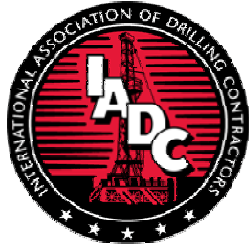

Minutes:

Logan Puckett welcomed all attendees.

Mike Killalea noted that the IADC antitrust notification was mentioned at the bottom of the agenda handout.

The SC discussed the reliability survey data set and all details are now in place. Drop downs and details to be completed by Togrul Mamedbekov and Brian Parks at IADC. Assistance is being rendered by Don Shafer, Athens Group.

Further discussions of the data security and the integrity of the data were held. Segregation will be maintained so that no manufacturer or contractor will be able to their competitor's information. A general data set will be available for all viewers and it will not have any detail that might make the information identifiable as to owner or manufacturer.

Our goal is to launch the page in active mode by the end of June.

It was decided that the top ten users would first be approached to participate. It was felt that if this is accomplished then peer pressure should bring other users to the survey.
