Minutes:

Joe Eustace opened the meeting by noting and thanking everyone for such good attendance. He then asked Holly Shock to review the IADC Antitrust Policy and Guidelines for the group.

The next item of business was a review of the committee report on WELLCAP by Kenny Jordan of the AESC.

Mr. Jordan worked with numerous members to develop questions of key concern. After discussion and modification by Brenda Kelly, Mike Killalea and Mr. Jordan, Brian Parks developed the e-survey on IADC's licensed site on SurveyMonkey.com.

IADC has developed a list of US and International well-servicing companies, and will solicit their participation in the next few days. IADC will supply the SurveyMonkey.com link to AESC for its member solicitation effort. Reminders will follow in due course.

IADC will compile the results in early January and post them for review by the committee. The committee will formulate an action plan based on the results of the survey at the next meeting.

Joe Freeman gave a report on vehicle monitoring systems for well service vehicles followed by a lengthy discussion on the benefits each contractor has experienced. The consensus was that the device was very helpful in keeping incidents and company vehicle abuse at a minimum. Joe Eustace will see about preparing an article for the IADC magazine during the year 2010.

The next item for discussion was the selection of a new committee chairman. Joe Eustace recommended that the IADC send out a request for nominations and select a new chairman at the February, 2010 meeting.
