Topics:

- An update was presented regarding the IADC Well Servicing Committee's report to the IADC Well Control Committee.
- The objective of the IADC Well Servicing Committee's review of the current IADC Well Control Curriculum and the urgency of addressing any gaps.
- Status of the Drilling Course as a stand alone course or in a combination associated with the Workover/Completion Course and not with any other well servicing courses, i.e., snubbing, coiled tubing, wireline. This is currently under review.
- Status of the 36 Hour, Supervisor Level, Stand-Alone Snubbing Course and that WCS is currently researching the development of this course.
- IADC Well Control Curriculum for well servicing was discussed and that it effectively addresses the well control competency-based training requirements of the industry however there may be areas of improvement with more emphasis (time) on specific disciplines.
- Training levels, i.e., Introductory, Fundamental, Supervisory, were discussed and the need to define personnel in the supply chain requiring a specific training level.

Action Items:

- A defined plan and timeline from IADC to effectively address the required training levels for well servicing personnel.
- A tentative date for the next IADC Well Servicing Committee Meeting.
