Minutes:

IADC Well Servicing Committee Chairman Joe Eustace opened the meeting and welcomed the attendees.

Mike Killalea reminded the attendees that IADC meetings comply with all antitrust statute, and noted that the complete IADC Antitrust Policy is posted at www.iadc.org/antitrust.htm.

The committee reviewed the minutes of the last meeting, held 24 March, 2009. The minutes were approved.

Next, Brenda Kelly, IADC Director-Accreditation & Certification Programs, made a presentation on IADC WellCAP programs for well servicing & workover. The committee observed that the items included under the “well servicing” accreditation program – wireline, snubbing and coiled tubing – would be more accurately termed “well services”.

There was a brief discussion of the nuances dividing well servicing and workover. The latter is a more appropriate term when a pump is on the location.

A task force led by Kenny Jordan and including James Newman, Basic Well Servicing, Barry Cooper, Well Control School, Richard Moore, Key Energy Services; and Cleon Shelton, Nabors Well Services, committed to reviewing the existing IADC WellCAP accreditation program for workover and making suggestions.

The committee discussed the meeting schedule of the IADC Well Control Committee. The WC Committee next meets in Denver on 24 August, just prior to the IADC Well Control Conference of the Americas, 25-26 August. Mike Killalea was asked to see if the committee had time on its agenda to discuss well servicing/workover well control training. (NOTE: MKK has emailed the WC Chairman, Brian Maness.)

Cleon Shelton reported that the planned article by Steve Olsen, Nabors, on JSAs, is well under way. It is on schedule for July completion, and is slated for publication in the Sept/Oct DC.

Then the committee discussed future areas to publicize:

- Well control: Future articles by Richard DeBuys are forthcoming, probably in the Nov/Dec DC;
- Emergency Action Response Plans were suggested for coverage in the January/February edition;

The next meeting was scheduled for 10:30 on 2 September.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
