Facilitator Certification Course

This four-day course is designed to teach how to facilitate a WellCAP or WellCAP Plus course.*

Course Objectives:

- Establish an interactive learning environment
- Exhibit effective communication and presentation skills
- Demonstrate effective questioning skills
- Introduce, manage and process exercises
- Synthesize the learning

Eligibility:

- Approved WellCAP instructor holding at least two valid supervisory-level well control certificates. (minimum drilling subsea including workover-completions courses)
- Actively teaching well control for 2 years, or assistant instructor for at least 3 years.
