Training Providers seeking to obtain and maintain IADC accreditation for their well control training programs are subject to the following fees, effective 1 January 2009.

- The above fees will be effective until further notice. Prices are quoted in US dollars. Contact IADC for additional wire transfer information or information on international orders.
- Fees must be paid at time of initial application or annual renewal. Payment of fees does NOT guarantee that accreditation will be approved – all applications and requests for renewal are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (WCT-1). For an initial application, fifty percent (50%) of the accreditation fee will be refunded in the event the application is withdrawn. In the event the application is rejected, the accreditation fee is non-refundable.
- Additional fees may be required for site visits as provided for in the Accreditation Procedures. Accreditation may be revoked if fees are in arrears. For more information, refer to the Accreditation Procedures section of the Handbook for Accreditation.
- Certificate Exchange Policy – Training providers will be allowed to exchange up to 10 certificates per quarter or 40 per year at a charge of shipping and handling charges only. Any certificates returned in excess 40 yearly, will be charged at the full certificate rate.
- One basic Associate Membership in IADC is included in the price for initial accreditation and annual renewals. The basic IADC membership provides one directory listing/location with two personnel. The basic membership may be upgraded at the member's expense to include additional listings/locations and personnel.
- Programs operated by contractors and producers will be awarded Associate Membership for the training department or other unit(s) accredited under WellCAP, separate from any other membership status the company may have.
