Companies or institutions seeking to obtain and maintain IADC accreditation for WellCAP Plus instruction are subject to the following fees, effective 1 January 2011. (Note: WellCAP Plus is available only to currently accredited WellCAP programs, and has separate procedures [and fees](#) for program review, renewal and audits.)

Payment of fees does NOT guarantee that accreditation will be approved -- all applications and requests for renewal are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the *Handbook for Accreditation* (WCT-01) and WellCAP Plus Accreditation Procedures (WCP-01). For an initial application, fifty percent (50%) of the accreditation fee will be refunded in the event the application is withdrawn prior to completion of processing. In the event the application is rejected, the accreditation fee is non-refundable.

Additional fees [are](#) required for site visits as provided for in the Accreditation Procedures. Accreditation may be revoked if fees are in arrears.
