INSTRUCTIONS



**2018 – 2019**

The OKLAHOMA-TEXAS PANHANDLE CHAPTER of IADC will award a number of \$2,000 scholarships this year to qualified students whom are either employed by a drilling contractor whose current OKC IADC membership is in good standing OR whose parents or legal guardians are current OKC IADC members in good standing. Complete applications must be returned to the address below by

**May 31<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

*Applications received after this date will not be considered.*

*Current high school students expecting to graduate in May 2018 are eligible to apply and if awarded a scholarship will need to provide proof of graduation (final transcript) in order to receive scholarship.)*

*Note:*

- *Scholarships will be awarded \$1,000 per semester after receiving a copy of latest semester grades (2.50 min) and the next semester schedule showing at least 12 hours.*
- *If you receive the fall scholarship you must send in grades and schedule by January 1 to receive the spring semester's \$1000 scholarship.*
- *You must reapply annually by the highlighted date above to be considered for Fall Scholarship.*

## OKLAHOMA-TEXAS PANHANDLE CHAPTER IADC SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- A. Fund Scholarships.
  - 1. 1/2-Drilling Contractors employee's children or legal guardian.
  - 2. 1/2-Associate or Operator scholarship employee's children or legal guardian.
  
- B. Contractor, Associate or Operator must be a member in good standing.  
**Drilling Contractor** must be a member in good standing.  
**Associate / Operator** memberships require each *individual* parent or guardian to be a member in good standing.
  
- C. Selection Criteria.
  - 1. Based on Financial need.
  - 2. Academic accomplishments.
  - 3. Must be a high school graduate.
  - 4. Must have a 2.5 G.P.A. or Higher.
  - 5. If currently a college student must have a 2.5 G.P.A. for the prior semester & must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester.
  - 6. **It is the student's responsibility to provide the scholarship chairman with the name and correct address for their school bursar official and office.**
  
- D. OK-TX IADC will fund a maximum of \$2,000.00 per year, based on \$1,000.00 each for a fall and spring semester.
  
- E. Scholarship will pay direct to the school, for the following:
  - 1. Tuition
  - 2. Books
  - 3. Class Fees

Any amount *refunded* will be returned to the Chapter Fund.

- F. All eligible applicants will submit application for consideration each year, including prior recipients.
- G. Applications will be submitted through the member company, and employment will be verified.
- H. At the end of each semester, recipient will furnish the local Chapter with a certified copy of transcript with a 2.5 G.P.A. or higher to be eligible for the following semester.
- I. Maximum amount that will be awarded to an individual will be \$8,000.00 or 4 years @ \$2,000.00 per year. No scholarship will be paid for graduate schooling (MBA, etc.).
- J. The scholarship committee shall be composed of the following:
  - 1. Active Chairman
  - 2. Active Vice Chairman
  - 3. Active Secretary
- 4. Special Fund Trustee
