Agenda Item: Welcome and Introductions

Justin Hodges, Committee Chairman opened the meeting. Joe Hurt gave a safety briefing and explanation of the building facilities. Justin then asked the attendees to introduce themselves, see the attendance list. Justin then thanked David Cain and Patterson-UTI for hosting the meeting.

## Agenda Item: General Discussion – Safety Minute – Best Practices

The attendees discussed a number of incidents that have occurred in the upstream industry dealing with failures of hoisting equipment or related to rig moving operations as well as other upstream industry lifting incidents.

There was discussion on how to determine the type of metal that was used in trucks already in service. KR reported that there is a device that can be used for Positive Metal Identification (PMI). The device is Thermo Scientific Nitron x-ray fluorescence (XRF) analyzer.

**Agenda Item:** Presentation on inspecting equipment used in rigging and lifting operations by Billy Bob Anderson, Bishop Lifting Products. The presentation discussed visual as well as non-destructive inspection/testing of lifting gear and equipment.

**Agenda Item:** Sargent Bart Teeter and Trooper Shawn Baxter of the Texas Department of Public Safety Commercial Vehicle Enforcement gave a very informative discussion on what to do after a vehicle accident. They discussed pictures, what to say, as well as what information to gather. They also cautioned everyone not to jump to conclusions or make comments that may not be supported by the evidence once it is all gathered. The officers fielded numerous questions that the attendee asked.

**Agenda Item:** Justin went through the process for determining the working load limits, safety factor and developing a load chart. It was decided by the attendees that the committee should develop a spreadsheet that truck owners could enter data into that can be used in the calculation of the working load limit of the truck. Justin offered to develop draft spreadsheet for the committee to review.

## Agenda Item: Gin-Pole Truck Guidelines

Joe Hurt informed the committee that the guidelines have been posted on the Rig Moving Committee Web page since March 1, 2010. He also reported that he has made introductory presentations to a number of OSHA STEPS Alliance network meetings.
