Agenda Item: Welcome and Introductions

- Charlie Vannatta, Committee Chairman, opened the meeting with a safety briefing of the facilities. He then gave a brief summary of the purpose of the committee and asked the attendees to introduce themselves (see the attendance list).
- Rhett Winter emphasized the point to the attendees that the purpose of the meetings is to share best practices and network together for the good of the industry.

Agenda Item: General Discussion, Best Practices & Regulatory Update

- Charlie Vannatta Opened the floor for general discussion, safety alerts & best practices.
 Some of the issues discussed were:
 - Vice Chairman, Daniel Taylor of Lariat Services next informed the committee of the Permian Chapter HSE committee that meets the 2nd Monday of each month in the Midland/Odessa area. Daniel encourage everyone with operations in the area to attend.
 - Anthony Zacniewski of Bandera Drilling also informed the committee about the local Permian Chapter and getting involved, stating that IADC needs more involvement from the drilling contractors.
 - Rhett then asked the attendees if anyone commented to the docket regarding the FMCSA Hours of Service Exemption. Additionally, he showed a copy of the comments submitted by IADC and how to gain access to the document. Also, after some concern from committee members, he next read the IADC letter to OSHA(and OSHA's reply) regarding well site preparation and rigging up/down. This is the only aspect that is covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1926, all other aspects are covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1910.

Agenda Item: Competency Task Group Update

• Charlie Vannatta and Rhett Winter — Charlie and Rhett informed the committee that the Forklift operator document has now been completed and will be posted to the website within three weeks. The task group's next document will be the initial start of the Truck Pusher competency guidelines. The next meeting date will be October 1st in Shreveport, LA (location TBD). Charlie reminded the group that the templates are completely voluntary.

The competencies can be developed in-house and added to your training program. The template can be customized to fit your company's needs and operations. Our goal is to stay out in front of OSHA and to assist companies with providing a safe work environment for their employees.

• Presentation – Faces of Meth / John Floyd – Texas J Regional Advisory Council

- John's presentation focused on the devastating impact of meth on the human body and its problem to the oilfield.
- John also explained Texas J RAC's mission and their involvement in the industry. Daniel Taylor, Jimmy Fry and Billy Anderson all gave examples of how drugs have impacted their workforce, and that meth is the worst due to its impurities. The majority of other drugs stem from natural substances, but with meth, the body gets overwhelmed.

Q & A – Sgt. Robert Guebara & Sgt. Chris Bryan – Texas DPS

- Sgt. Guebara and Sgt. Bryan started by stating where they (the TX DPS) are seeing the most violations in regards to Commercial Vehicle Enforcement. Their target area is Midland, TX and Fort Stockton, TX
- Questions from the committee included: Is there a time limit to contact DOT with any questions regarding an inspection violation? What is the policy on a low-level inspection? Is aiding & abetting aggressively enforced? The answers are as follows: there is no Restricted time limit as long as you have the ticket number. On inspections, Sgt. Guebara Teaches his officers to issue clean inspections, not low level...and aiding & abetting is Strictly enforced.
